On Labor Day Weekend Alamo City Outdoors is offering a **Labor Day Weekend Campout** to the **Big Bend National Park Chisos Basin**. We will leave on Friday, September 3 and return on Monday, September 6.

Cost is \$25 per person and includes camp site for three nights and four days and breakfast every morning. We will enjoy tent camping, hiking, bird watching, Christian fellowship, and outdoor worship on Sunday morning.

Campers must be at least age 18 (we recommend that children be at least age 8 and must be escorted by a guardian). We will carpool from San Antonio to Big Bend. Register online or at the ACO Booth in the hall.

The Chisos Basin Campground is rugged and hilly at an altitude of 5,400 feet. The sites are small and not suited to recreational vehicles or trailers. The road to the Basin is steep and curvy, especially at Panther Pass—the road's highest point. The road into the campground is a 15 percent grade. Flush toilets, running water, grills, and picnic tables are available. There are no hook-ups.
